



CURRICULUM COMPLIANCE POLICY

1. In this respect, the school seeks:

It is the policy of the school that all pupils are taught to be sensitive and show appropriate respect to UAE culture and the Islamic religion.

2. Aims:

The aim of this policy is to ensure that:

- All resources, all aspects of the curriculum and all teaching materials and resources are culturally, socially, and religiously sensitive to UAE culture and the Islamic religion, and in line with all ADEK and Ministry of Education requirements for educational materials.
- To outline the formal process that is in place to screen all materials to ensure that they are compliant with this aim.
- To support school staff in the following Beaconhouse Private School and ADEK sensitive topics Display and Usage Policy.
- To support and train School staff to make sensible, wise, and respectful decisions regarding pupils' access to materials considered inappropriate.
- Outline the role and responsibilities of the school committee that is responsible for the review of the curriculum, books, teaching materials, online resources, and all sources of pupil information to ensure that they do not contain inappropriate language and are culturally, socially and religiously sensitive to UAE culture and the Islamic religion, and in line with all ADEK and Ministry of Education requirements for educational materials.
- Outline the role and responsibility of the School Principal in ensuring the school achieves its aims in this area.

3. Practice and Procedure:

3.1 Formal screening process within key stages

The following process must be followed with by all curriculum departments for all books and resources that are used by students:

- All resources that are distributed to students for use in school must be screened to ensure that any sections of the resources used meet all requirements.
- A separate Resources Vetting check list must be completed for each type of resource that is used by students to ensure that it meets all points on the sensitive topic list issued by ADEK. A copy of the check lists will be held in the department and a copy of all check lists given to the Principal's PA who will keep them for the Principal and ADEK reference.
- If any materials are found to be considered offensive or inappropriate, they will be removed immediately.
